SCBC INCLEMENT WEATHER GUIDELINES

Monday – Friday

- **The first day** inclement weather occurs, the church will be closed if Chesterfield County schools are closed. The church office and all meetings will be cancelled this day.
- **The second day** and subsequent sequential days, notice will be placed on the church voice mail at least one hour prior to the first meeting.
- If we have electricity, we will put a notice on the church website.

Saturdays

- If inclement weather occurs Friday night or early Saturday morning, meetings/activities may be cancelled.
- A notice will be placed on the church voice mail at least one hour prior to the first meeting.
- If we have electricity, we will put a notice on the church website.

Sundays

- If inclement weather occurs Saturday night or early Sunday morning, notice will be placed on the church voice mail by 7AM Sunday morning.
 - Cancellations will also be aired on the local TV stations: WTVR Channel 6, WRIC Channel 8 and closing website for WWBT Channel 12.
